Town Council Meeting

The meeting was opened at 6:32 by President E. Leonard, A. Hardin, B. Patterson, J. Adams & Town Attorney, T. Beeman were present. Clerk treasurer Deb Dunham was also present. J. Taylor was not present.

Meeting opened with Brady from Commonwealth going over the Water Plant & Well Project. Discussion regarding Work Change Directive No. B-2, along Anderson Rd., Contract Price Decrease TBD. Also Work Change Directive No. B-3, along Circle Dr. \$12,084 Contract Price Increase. J. Adams made a motion to approve and 2<sup>nd</sup> by B. Patterson and all voted yes. 


Police- nothing to discuss.
